Plan Today. Stay Safe Tomorrow.



Weather Alerts

Stay informed about severe weather in your area.



Emergency Kit

Pack essentials: water, food, first aid, flashlight, batteries, medications.



Secure Outdoor Items

Bring in or tie down anything that could blow away.



Charge Devices

Keep phones and power banks fully charged.



Know Shelter Areas

Identify safe places to go if needed.



Check Drains

Clear leaves and debris to prevent flooding.

Outdoors & Driving: Stay Safe



Seek Shelter

Get inside a sturdy building.



Avoid Open Areas

Stay away from fields, hills, and ridges.



Do Not Stand Under Trees

Lightning can strike nearby.



Slow Down

Reduce speed and increase distances.



Pull Over Safely

Stop in a safe location off the road.



Never Drive Through Floodwater

Just a few inches can sweep a car away.
